EPOXY ACCELERATOR IS AN INDUSTRY STANDARD EPOXY ACCELERATOR, IT MAY BE USED WITH MOST EPOXY SYSTEMS.

USES

Accelerator is an industry standard epoxy accelerator. It may be used with most epoxy systems. Chemically it is tris 2,4,6dimethylaminomethyl phenol. It thus has 3 tertiary amines and a phenolic hydroxyl all in the same molecule and each group functions as an epoxy/amine accelerator. It may also be used to speed up polysulfide and mercaptan cured systems. Care should be taken with its use as it will both speed up cure but also reduce pot life and thus useable working time.

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SURFACE PREP & APPLICATION CONDITIONS:

Concrete surface must be clean

APPLICATION & CLEAN UP:

Clean-up: Use xylene. Dispose of containers in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.
